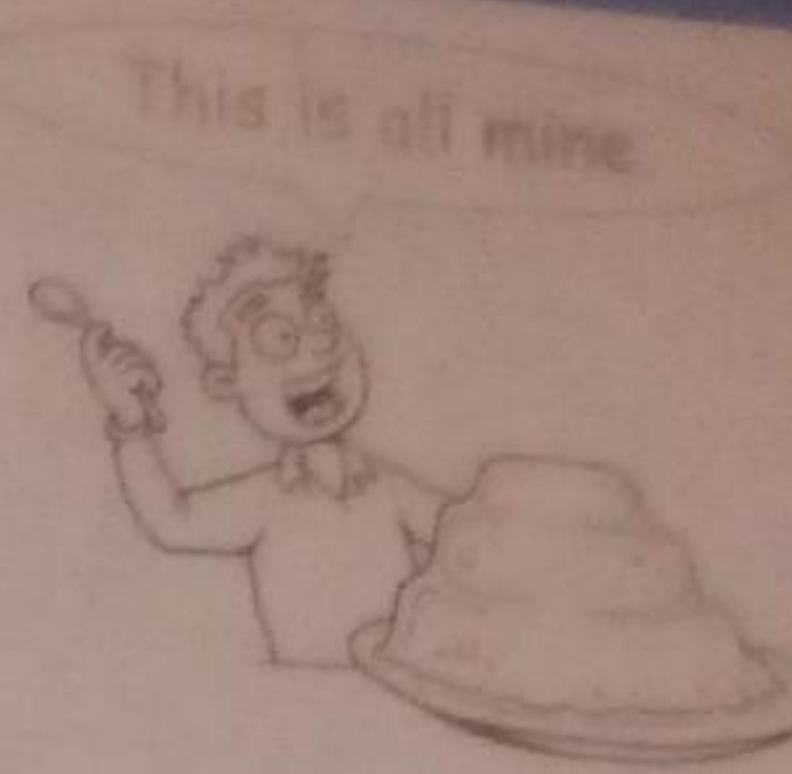


Pronouns are words that are used instead of nouns.
